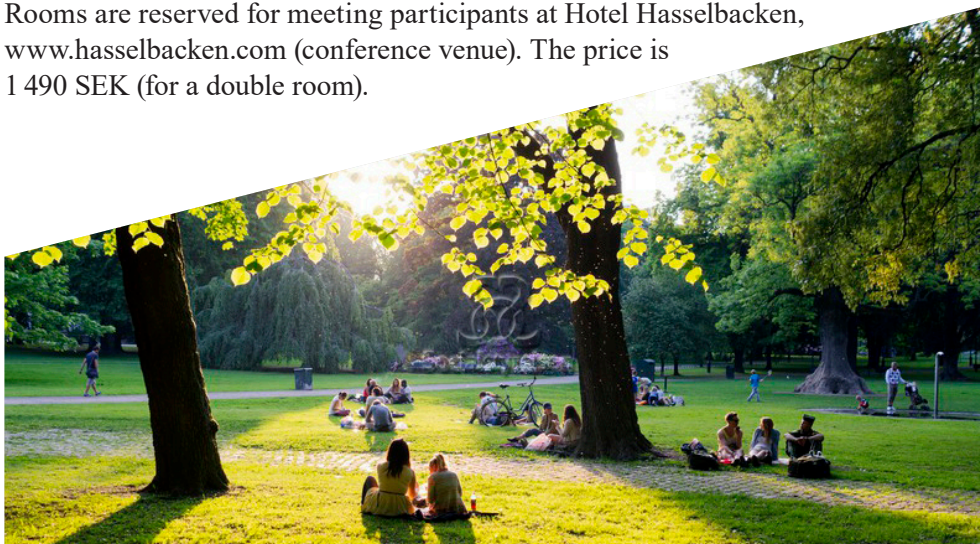

- Main topics for the 2019 ANCR symposium are cancer prevention, cancer screening, cancer registration, methods for cancer registry data, cancer care and outcomes
- Indicate whether you prefer oral or poster presentation
- Abstracts must be submitted in English. All presentations will be in English
- Submission deadline is April 28th
- Contributions will be evaluated by the scientific committee
- Abstracts are restricted to a maximum of 250 words and will be accepted in the following formats: MS Word (doc, docx), rich text format (rtf) or text only (txt)
- Abstracts should include the following (when applicable):
 - Title
 - Author/s, underline presenter
 - Institutes
 - Background
 - Materials & methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions

Pre-symposium workshop I:

Current challenges in coding and cancer registration

Target audience

Staff at the Nordic cancer registries who work with collection and registration of cancer notifications.

The aim of the workshop is to improve the understanding of differences and similarities between the Nordic cancer registers, for example regarding organization, work-flows, registration application, tools, education and training. Registered participants will receive further e-mails about work-shop preparations.

Pre-symposium workshop II:

***Descriptive cancer epidemiology using cancer registry data
– an overview of measures***

Target audience

Cancer registry staff, epidemiologists, statisticians, clinicians, students and senior staff, who wish to discuss and deepen their conceptual knowledge of descriptive cancer epidemiology using registry data.

The workshop will cover statistical measures used in cancer reporting, such as incidence, mortality and survival, with a focus on survival measures. Some basic knowledge of cancer survival methodology is recommended, but is not necessary. The workshop aims to convey an understanding of commonly used measures on a conceptual level. Traditional measures as well as more recently developed measures will be discussed.
